Candidate must have expert-level knowledge of the goals, strategies, and methods through which cyber-capabilities can and are employed within a military context. Expert level knowledge of cyber operations in the context of cross and all-domain perspectives of the battle-field: air, surface, subsurface, space, and cyberspace. Ability to provide cyber insights, injects, and perspective into MCU wargames. Excellent written and oral communications.

Has previous experience teaching cyber-related topics and courses within a military context.
